Front Adjustable Control Arm Installation

- 1. Perform pre-alignment in a normal manner
- 2. Install alignment equipment, record readings, and determine the amount of change needed.
- 3. Raise the front of vehicle and allow the suspension to hang.
- 4. Remove the wheel and tire assembly.
- 5. Remove the pinch bolts from the steering knuckle.
- 6. Remove upper ball joint from steering knuckle.
- 7. Do not allow the steering knuckle or brake calipers to hang.
- 8. Remove control arm fastening bolts.
- 9. Install new arms and adjust by turning the hex nut, so the new arms are nearly the same length as the OEM arms.
- 10. Re-install tire and wheel assembly and perform wheel alignment.
- 11. Adjust control arms to the desired camber and caster change.
- 12. Tighten pinch bolts, hex nuts to manufactures specification.
- 13. Re-set the toe and road test vehicle.
